The proposed installation of the new booster station Project at the ROWCO facility has been determined to have no potential to cause significant adverse effects on the environment and will ensure the facility continues to operate as is, but with greater efficiency and reliability to the distribution system. Categorical Exemption Class I exempts "operation, repair, maintenance...or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities and mechanical equipment...involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that existing at the time of the lead agency's determination." The exceptions to the issuance of Categorical Exemptions have been evaluated for the proposed project activities. The proposed installation and operation of the ROWCO Booster Station Relocation Project has been determined not to have a potential to cause significant adverse environmental effects as a result of any of the exceptions. Therefore, this proposed action is not forecast to cause any potential for significant adverse environmental impacts and qualifies with the requirements for Class 1 exemption.
