The MDAQMD is therefore taking this action to officially remove SCAOMD 1173 from the SIP for the Blythe/Palo Verde Valley area within the jurisdiction of the MDAQMD and to acknowledge its replacement with currently approved MDAQMD Rule 1102, various approved Federal Negative Declarations and the SIP approved portions of 17 Cal. Code Regulations §§95665 et. Seq.
