Project Title: Glen Helen Parkway Grade Separation Project at Burlington Santa Fe Railroad – Railroad License Agreements

Project Location: Glen Helen Parkway, between Glen Helen Road and Cajon Boulevard, in the unincorporated area of Devore, San Bernardino County

Project Description: The project consists of the approval of two licensing agreements for two pipeline crossings included in the Glen Helen Grade Separation Project (DPW WO#H14057). The license agreements include a pipeline license agreement with Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railroad and a pipeline crossing agreement with Union Pacific Railroad. The agreements are required to acquire non-exclusive licenses from the railroad companies referenced above, to allow for ongoing, permitted use of railroad right-of-way thereby allowing the County to construct storm drain improvements adjacent to the grade separation structure.
