Project Description

Project Title: San Bernardino County Flood Control District – Lytle Creek Gatehouse Security Fencing and Repairs

Project Location: The flood facility slated for fencing is the Lytle Creek Gatehouse, positioned at the junction of Foothill Boulevard and W 5th Street in the city of San Bernardino, situated within San Bernardino County.

Project Description: Approximately 350 feet of wrought iron security fencing will be installed around the perimeter of the gatehouse. Previous incidents of vandalism have resulted in electrical, structural, and mechanical damage to the facility, rendering the flow-controlling gate inoperative. The gate, measuring approximately 60-70 feet in width and 60 feet in height, plays a crucial role in flood control by managing flow volume, thus mitigating the risk of flooding. Security fencing is essential to protect the facility during repairs and prevent further vandalism. After the security gate is installed, repairs will be undertaken to rectify the damages.
