


## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

Notice of Intent to Adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration

## Lytle Creek Bridge Seismic Retrofit

Do you want a public hearing on the proposed project?



WHAT'S BEING PLANNED? The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to retrofit or replace Lytle Creek Bridge (Bridge No. 54-0422) on State Route 210U (SR-210U), E. Highland Avenue, post mile (PM) 20.8. The project location is in the city of San Bernardino, bordering the city of Rialto, within the County of San Bernardino.

WHY THIS NOTICE?

Caltrans has studied the effects this project may have on the environment. Our studies show it will not significantly affect the quality of the environment. The report that explains the effects of the project is called an *Initial Study (IS)*. This notice is to advise you of the preparation of the *Draft Initial Study with Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND)* and of its availability for you to read and to offer the opportunity for a public hearing.

WHAT'S AVAILABLE?

Maps for the *Draft IS with Proposed MND* and other project information are available for review and copying at the Caltrans District 8 Office (464 W 4<sup>th</sup> Street, San Bernardino, 92401) on weekdays from 8 am to 4pm. Please provide a minimum 24-hour notice prior to visiting the District office to view available documents.
