Project Description

Project Title: Zone 2 - Sand Creek, Channel and Basin - Portions of APN's 0285-153-14, 15 and Portions of APN's 0285-121-04, 14, 30, 33 & 34

Project Location: The location of the easement proposed to be relinquished generally lies to the north of the City of San Bernardino, adjacent to the northern most portion of Victoria Blvd. and North of San Manuel Blvd. San Bernardino County (see Location Map).

Project Description: The San Bernardino County Flood Control District (District) is proposing to relinquish 28.75 acres of easement as surplus property to San Manuel Band of Mission Indians. The San Manuel Band of Mission Indians is requesting to obtain surplus property from the District for a portion of an existing drainage channel that is routed within the reservation boundary. The applicant understands that upon obtaining the surplus property, San Manuel will be responsible for maintenance of the channel.
