Project Location: The proposed project is located in the City of San Bernardino at the San Bernardino International Airport (SBIA) on taxiway, runway, and roadway shoulders as shown on the attached aerial photograph.

Reasons why project is exempt: The State CEQA Guidelines provide a series of Categorical Exemptions for actions that have been deemed by the State Legislature to be exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). The proposed installation of a new slurry seal along runway, taxiway and roadway shoulders within the SBIA within disturbed public rights-of-way has been determined to qualify for a Categorical Exemption under Section 15302(c) of the State CEQA Guidelines. Categorical Exemption 15302 (c) exempts "replacement or reconstruction of existing structures or facilities where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced, including but not limited to:" "(c) Replacement or reconstruction of existing utility systems and/or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of capacity." This proposed project has been determined to not fall under the jurisdiction of CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines because these activities fall within the scope of the qualifying criteria listed in Section 15302(c). Therefore, this action conforms to the requirements for a Categorical Exemption in compliance with Section 15302(c) of the State CEQA Guidelines.
