COUNTYWIDE OVERSIGHT BOARD

Health and Safety Code (HSC) section 34179(j) required the consolidation of the 26 oversight boards that were in place in San Bernardino County into one Countywide Oversight Board on July 1, 2018. The County Auditor-Controller is responsible for staffing the Countywide Oversight Board.

Items that may require Countywide Oversight Board approval include, but are not limited to: Annual and Last & Final Recognized Obligation Payment Schedules (ROPS), amendments to ROPS, modification to the Long Range Property Management Plan (LRPMP), property disposition that does not adhere to the LRPMP, bond refunding or refinancing, and wind-down activities pending successor agency formal dissolution.

The Countywide Oversight Board has recurring meetings on a bimonthly basis and may have multiple meetings in January to meet the ROPS submission deadline.

The Countywide Oversight Board consists of seven appointed members. Under Health and Safety Code section 34179(j)(2) and 34179(a)(11), the City Selection Committee may appoint one member and one alternate member to the Countywide Oversight Board. The remaining six members are appointed as follows:

- one member may be appointed by the County Board of Supervisors;
- one member may be appointed by the Chancellor of the California Community Colleges;
- one member of the public may be appointed by the County Board of Supervisors; and
- one member may be appointed by the recognized employee organization representing the largest number of successor agency employees in the County.

Pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 34179(k), the Governor may make the appointment if the member position remains vacant for more than 60 days.

The Countywide Oversight Board became effective on July 1, 2018. Members serve without compensation or reimbursement for expenses and have no personal liability. Members serve at the pleasure of the respective appointing authority (there is no term of office). Appointees need not be residents of the County of San Bernardino.
